## **ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES**

The scholarship is available to persons who:

- ◆ are residents of the Westran School District
- ◆ have a high school diploma or a G.E.D.
- ◆ enrolled as undergraduate students in a vocational or trade school or college
- ◆ enrolled as a full-time or part-time student
- ◆ are adults returning to school after being in the work force

Eligibility guidelines are pursuant to such rules and requirements as The Living Memorial Scholarship Board may devise, establish, adopt, and amend from time to time. Scholarships are awarded on the availability of money.

## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- ◆ Application must be written with dark ink or typewritten.
- ◆ Attach a photocopy of your high school transcript or G.E.D. certificate. Or, if you are currently attending, or have in the past attended, a college, trade school, or vocational school, attach a photocopy of such transcript.
- ◆ Application must be postmarked by **August 30**. Late applications will not be considered.
- ◆ Application cannot be amended after submission, but the selection committee can request additional information.
- ◆ Applicant may be required to be interviewed by the selection committee.
- ◆ Any false or misleading information in the application will automatically disqualify the application from further consideration.
- ◆ Incomplete applications will not be considered. (Use the initials NA to indicate questions that are not applicable.)
